

# Curio.ca

Curio.ca provides access to content from CBC and Radio-Canada, including documentaries from television and radio, news reports, archival material and more.

To access curio.ca outside a library location, or to use personalized features of Curio, you will need to create an account:

- Click the “Login” button located at the top of the screen.
- Click the link under the “Got an access code?” heading
- Enter the access code **298N-ALFJ**
- Fill out the rest of the form and click “Continue”.
- An activation link will be sent to you by email. Follow the link in the email and login with your email and password.

## Finding Content

There are multiple ways to find content on Curio. Using the main menu that always appears at the top of the page, you can navigate curio.ca by Shows, Categories, Collections, Resources and Channels. You may also search the site by click the magnifying glass icon.

- **Shows**  
Select “Shows” for a list of the most popular CBC television programs. Click “All Shows” to see the full list of programs available on Curio.
- **Categories**  
Select “Categories” to view a list of topics, including Business, Health and more. Click on any category to find related programs.
- **Collections**  
Select “Collections to find CBC mini-series, thematic bundles and individual seasons of certain programs.
- **Resources**  
Some programs are accompanied by teacher resource guides in PDF format. A full list of guides can be found here.
- **Channels**  
Select “Channels” to browse “News in Review” for the current year, as well as the past 25 years.

Once you are logged in, and have selected a program to watch, you can:

- **Share**  
Click the “Share” link below the video player to see the video url and embed code.
- **Create Playlists**  
Click the “Add to Playlist” link below the video player. To view or manage your playlists, click the “Account” link at the top of the page.
- **Add Annotations**  
Click the “Annotate” link below the video player. This will allow you to click anywhere in the selected program’s timeline to add chapter titles and descriptions. The next time you watch the video, you will see and be able to click on your annotations.
