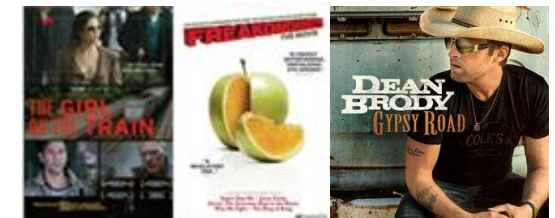
# User Guide

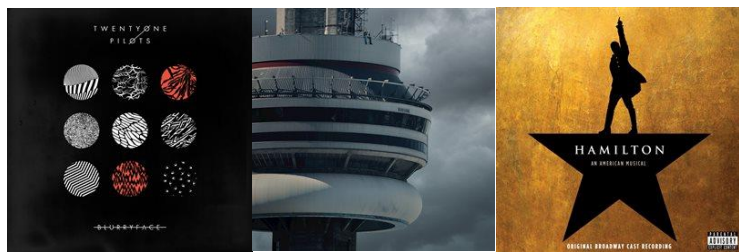

## Tablet, Smartphone or Mobile Device


Stream or download movies, TV shows, music and audiobooks

- **Install** the Hoopla app from the App Store, Google Play or Amazon App Store\*  
\*For Kindle Fire devices
- **Open** the app and **tap** *Sign up* to create an account
- **Search** for *Kitchener Public Library*
- **Enter** your Account Information – email, password, library barcode
- **Click** the box to agree to allow Hoopla to validate your library card
- **Click** the notifications boxes if you wish to receive emails about Hoopla content and features
- **Select** *Sign Up Now* to create your account
- **Start** browsing by category or **search** for content by title, artist etc.
- **Tap** an item's cover, then **select** *Borrow* to check it out.
- **Select** *Play* to begin listening or viewing your selection.
- **Select** *Tap here to download* to enjoy your content when you are off-line!
- **Tap** the *Borrowed* tab to access content you currently have checked out



## Computer or Laptop

Stream movies, TV shows, music and audiobooks

- To play Hoopla videos on your computer, you need to install a plug-in. You will be prompted to install the plug-in when you play your first video through Hoopla.
- For all browsers, except Firefox, install [Widevine plug-in](https://tools.google.com/dlpage/widevine) (<https://tools.google.com/dlpage/widevine>)
- For Firefox install [SilverLight plug-in](https://www.microsoft.com/getsilverlight/Get-Started/Install/Default.aspx) (<https://www.microsoft.com/getsilverlight/Get-Started/Install/Default.aspx>)
- To create a Hoopla account, **go to** [kpl.org/movies](http://kpl.org/movies)
- Scroll down to the  icon
- **Select** *Use inside or outside the library*
- **Select** the *Log in* button, then the *Sign up* button to create an account
- **Select** *Kitchener Public Library*
- **Enter** your Account Information – email, password, library barcode
- **Click** the box to agree to allow Hoopla to validate your library card
- **Click** the notifications boxes if you wish to receive emails about Hoopla content and features
- **Start** browsing by category or **search** for content by title, artist etc.
- Once you have found a title, **select** the cover then **select** *Borrow* to check it out
- **Select** *Play* to begin listening or viewing your selection.
