What is Freegal Music?

Freegal is a free music service from your library offering access to 15 million songs and over 40,000 music videos from around the world. **Stream up to 6 hours of music a day, and download 5 songs a week to keep forever!**

How to Get Started with the Freegal App on a Smartphone or Tablet

- In the Google Play or Apple App Store, search for “Freegal Music”. Install and open the app.
- You may choose to allow the app to know your location.
 - If you don’t, fill in a Zip Code, City or Country in the next box.
- Choose “Kitchener Public Library” from the list.
- Fill in your library card number and tap “Log In”.

How to Get Started with Freegal on a Computer

- In an Internet browser, visit www.kpl.org/databases.
- Scroll down to “Freegal Music”.
- Choose “Use inside or outside library”.
- Choose “Login” in the top right corner.
- Fill in your library card number and choose the “Login” button.

Searching or Browsing in Freegal Music

- The Featured page will show you interesting songs, music videos, artists, audiobooks and playlists. Enjoy a free playlist curated by library staff every month!
- Use the “Browse” button to explore Freegal by trends, new arrivals, genres, playlist, artists, music videos, or audiobooks.
- To search, type a song title or artist name into the search box at the top of the page. Choose the magnifying glass or hit “Enter” on your keyboard to search.

Streaming and Downloading Music in Freegal Music

- Listen to albums online by clicking on the album cover and clicking the “Stream” button.
- Play individual songs by clicking on the “Play” button on the song image.

- On your smart device, you may choose to add to your streaming playlist.
 - Tap the three dots on the right hand side of the song.
 - Tap “Add to Streaming Playlist”.
- To download a song:
 - On the computer, click the download button (down arrow) on the right side of the song.
 - On your smart device, tap the three dots on the right side of the song. Tap “Download”.
- To view your downloaded songs, or to download a song again:
 - On your computer, click the “My Music” icon on the left side of the page.
 - On your smart device, tap the “My Music” icon in the bottom right of the app.

Make a Playlist in Freegal Music

- You can create playlists to save your favourite songs.
 - Choose “My Music”.
 - Choose “Playlists”.
 - Choose the plus symbol or “Create a Playlist”.
 - On your smart device, choose “My Streaming Playlist” if the playlist will be made of music you want to stream or “My Download Playlist” for downloaded music.
 - Name the playlist.
 - Start adding music to the playlist by tapping on the three dots beside a song.
 - On your computer, click “Add to Playlist” and choose your playlist.
 - On your smart device, tap “Add to Streaming Playlist” and choose your playlist.

Important to Know

- Streaming and downloading uses Internet bandwidth. Streaming requires active Internet to play. Downloading allows you to save the song to your device and play it without Internet later.
- A music video download costs two of your five available downloads per week.
