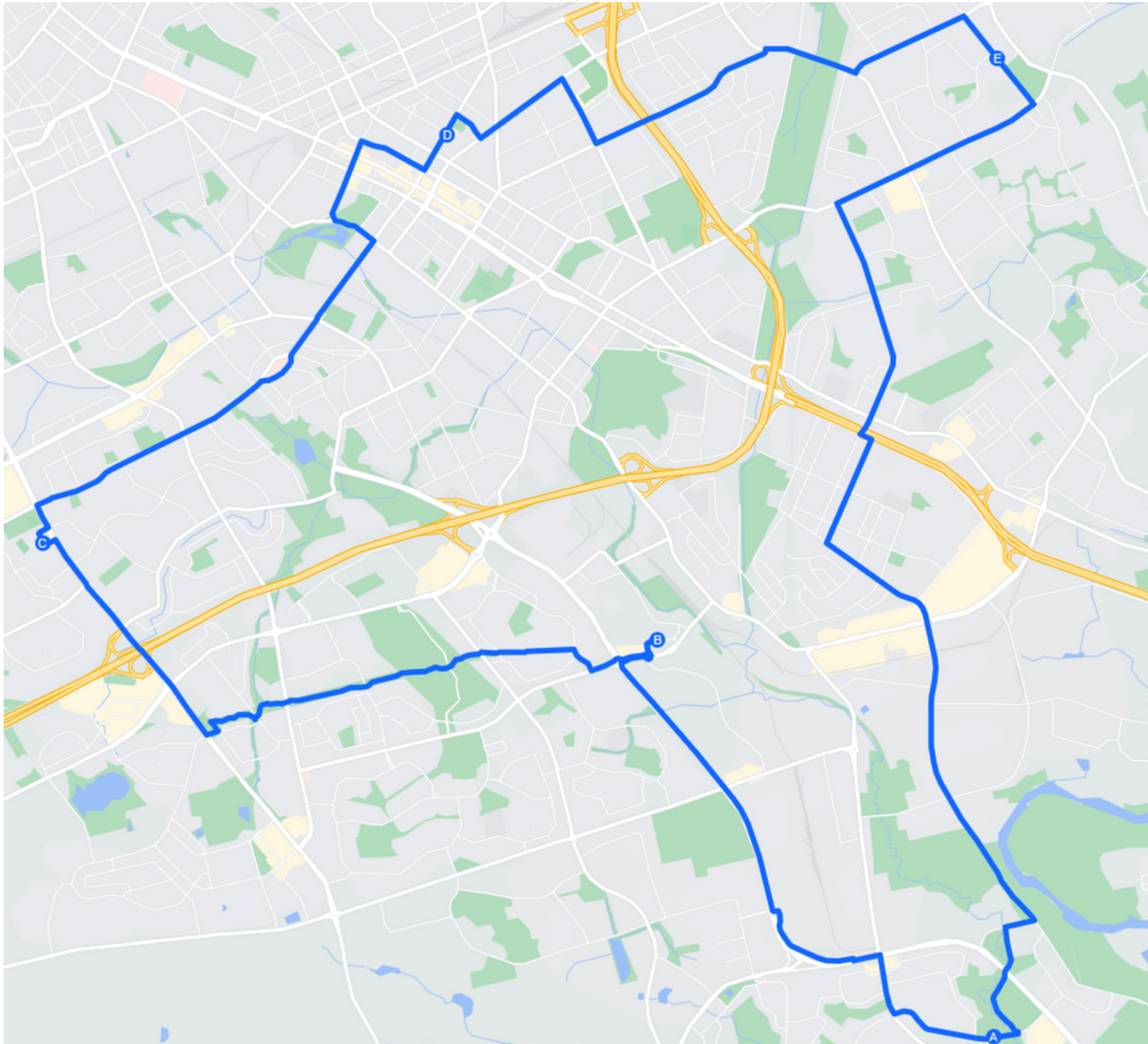


LIBRARY BIKE LOOP



Kitchener
Public Library

The ultimate 30km loop of all Kitchener Public Library locations



Looking for a biking challenge? Journey through Kitchener to visit all of our library locations by bike and learn some facts about the library while you do! Please load the online version of the map in [google maps](#) to see detailed information about the tour. The route takes approximately 2 hours by bike.

Conditions may vary - be sure to check for weather and construction.

START

A. Pioneer Park Library (150 Pioneer Dr)

Originally a location for a stationary Bookmobile, the current Pioneer Park location opened in 1989. Check out the toy collection, FastFoto scanner and interactive LUMOplay digital displays!

- Head west on Pioneer Dr toward Bechtel Dr
- Turn right on Doon Village Rd
- Turn left on Homer Watson Blvd and follow the trail
- Turn right onto Block Line at the roundabout
- Turn left onto Hanover St at the roundabout
- Arrive at:

B. Country Hills Library (1500 Block Line Rd)

The Country Hills location opened in 2004 and became the largest KPL community library location. Check out the music station!

- Head back to the roundabout and turn right onto Block Line
- Continue straight through the roundabout at Homer Watson
- Turn right on Kingswood Dr
- Turn left onto the Laurentian Trail
- Cross Williamsburg Rd then turn right and continue following the trail
- At the next fork, turn left
- At the next fork, turn right
- Turn right onto Fischer-Hallman Rd
- Turn left into:

C. Forest Heights Library (251 Fischer-Hallman Rd)

The Forest Heights location first opened in 1976 and is located right next to the Forest Heights pool and a skatepark. Check out the FastFoto Scanner and VHS conversion station!

- Turn left on Fischer-Hallman Rd
- Turn right on Queen's Blvd (becomes Queen St S)
- Turn left on Courtland Ave W (becomes Jubilee Dr)
- Turn right on Water St
- Turn right on Duke St
- Turn left on Queen St N
- Arrive at (on right):



D. Central Library (85 Queen St N)

First opened in 1962, the Central Library underwent a major renovation and expansion in 2014. Check out the Grace Schmidt Room of local history, Heffner Studio recording studios, and our specialized collections such as the Autism collection.

- Continue NE on Queen St N towards Otto St
- Turn right on Otto St
- Turn left on Frederick St
- Turn right on East Ave
- Turn left on Krug St
- Turn right on River Rd E
- Turn left on Lorraine Ave
- Turn right on Heritage Dr
- Arrive at (on right):

E. Grand River Stanley Park (175 Indian Rd)

The Grand River Stanley Park location was originally within the Sunnyside Retirement residence, before eventually being opened in its current location in 2002. Check out the embroidery machine!

- Continue SE on Heritage Dr towards Ottawa St N
- Turn right on Ottawa St N
- Turn left on Franklin St N
- Turn left on Kingsway Dr
- Turn right on Eight Ave
- Turn left on Wilson Rd
- Continue straight onto the trail
- Turn right on Huron Rd
- Left onto the trail before the creek
- At the fork turn right and cross Homer Watson Blvd
- Turn right on Pioneer Dr
- Finish at (on right):

F. Pioneer Park (150 Pioneer Rd)
