Accessing Curio

Ways to Use

- [Web Browser](#)

First Time Login

- Select “Login” (top right), then “Click here to register with an access code”.
- Complete the form with the following:
 - Access Code: 298N-ALFJ
 - Enter your email address and create password, then “Register”.
- Login to your email, open the activation email and select the activation link.

General Login

- Enter your: Email Address + Password

Using Curio

Browsing

- Search by Keyword or Topic:
 - Enter title, topic, or keywords in the search bar.
- Browse using Categories, Shows, Collections, and Channels.
 - Categories: a list of topics.
 - Shows: a list of popular CBC television programs.
 - Collections: CBC mini-series, thematic bundles, and select program seasons.
 - Additional Channels: KPL has “News in Review” access for the current year, up to 25 years ago. Others such as National Geographic are not included.

Watching

- General Controls
 - Play: red button
 - Pause: parallel lines at the bottom left of video
 - Volume: speaker icon
 - Share: Select “Share” below the video player (then copy the URL)

Learning

- Create Playlists: Select the “Add to Playlist” link below the video player.
 - Use the “Account” section at the top of the page to view playlists.
- Add Annotations (Notes): Select “Annotate” below the video player. Next, click anywhere in the selected program’s timeline to add descriptions and titles or notes.
- Teacher Resource Guides: some collections and documentaries have PDF guides. These are found on collection and program pages in the menu below the video.
