[Freegal](#) is a free music service with access to over 15 million songs and 40,000 music videos from around the world. The library supports unlimited streaming and allows you to download 5 songs each week which are yours to keep!

First Login

- Enter your Library Card Number
- Optional:
 - Add your email address (browser version)
 - Allow location access (app version)

- Enter your Library Card Number

Using Freegal Music

Browsing

- Featured Page: interesting songs, music videos, artists, audiobooks and playlists from Freegal as well as playlists from Kitchener Public Library.
- Browse: trends, new arrivals, genres, playlist, artists, music videos, or audiobooks.
- Search: type a song title or artist name into the search box at the top of the page.

Streaming

- You must be connected to the internet to stream music.
- Listen to albums by clicking on the album cover and then selecting “Stream”.
- Play individual songs by clicking on the “Play” button on the song image.
- In the app version, you may choose to add to your streaming playlist. Click the three dots on the right-hand side of the song, then “Add to Streaming Playlist”.

Downloading

- You must be connected to the internet to download music. You can listen to music that has finished downloading at anytime without an internet connection.
- To download individual songs:
 - In a web browser: click the download button (down arrow) on the song’s right.
 - In the app: click the three dots on the right side of the song, then “Download”.
- Viewing Downloads: choose the “My Music” icon.

Creating Playlists

- Create playlists to save your favourite songs:
 - Choose “My Music”, then “Playlists”
 - Choose the plus symbol or “Create a Playlist”
 - App users have options: “My Streaming Playlist” or “My Download Playlist”
 - Name the playlist
 - Add music to the playlist by selecting the three dots beside a song. Choose to “Add to Playlist”, “Add to Streaming Playlist” or “Add to Download Playlist”.
- The “Wishlist” can be used to recall songs you want to download in future.
 - Choose the star icon next to a song to add it to the Wishlist.

Important Notes

- A music video download costs two of your 5 available weekly downloads.
- Download limits reset on Mondays at 12:00 am Central Time (EST).
